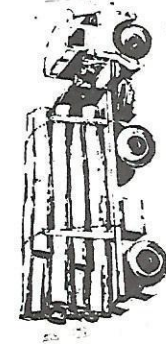

ALL TRACKED MACHINES

The Waitomo Rugby Club was formed at Hangatiki in the early 1920's. In the early years, there seems to have been some argument as to whether the club should have been in the Otorohanga or Maniapoto Sub-Unions. Consequently, the club has had various name changes during its history, being known in its early years as Hangatiki and at some time in the 1940's as Waitomo Valley.

The Hangatiki Club of the 1920's began with players like Brownie Nikora, Jackie Rata, Ted Barrett, Mac Kahu, Bags Taane, Koro Davis and many others.

Among many players who represented the King Country were Ben Davis, Koro Davis and Mac Kahu. The two latter players played for the Maori All Blacks.

In 1969, the present club was reformed under the name of the Waitomo Caves Rugby Football Club. Since then, the club has managed to field a senior grade team each season, despite a lack of playing members in some years. During the recent period, the club has been fortunate in having the loyal support of club members, Joe and Hiria Tahia, and such players as Walter Anderson, Joe Davis and Joe Hohaia.

Since being reformed in 1969, a number of players including Wayne Iti, Jackson Roach, Robert Tahia, Ted Davis and Mike Wanden have played at sub-division level, while Bayne Johnston and Karl Te Mata represented King Country in their respective age grades.
