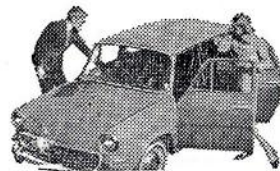

Waipawa United Football Club's Building Project

The Project started in the first week of November, 1971

Trees for the building had been cut and milled, some time in July. This had been undertaken by a team of workers and logs were transported by a local carrying firm.

The foundations were being boxed and poured by the end of November, and some two hundred yards of river fill were carried by three local contractors.

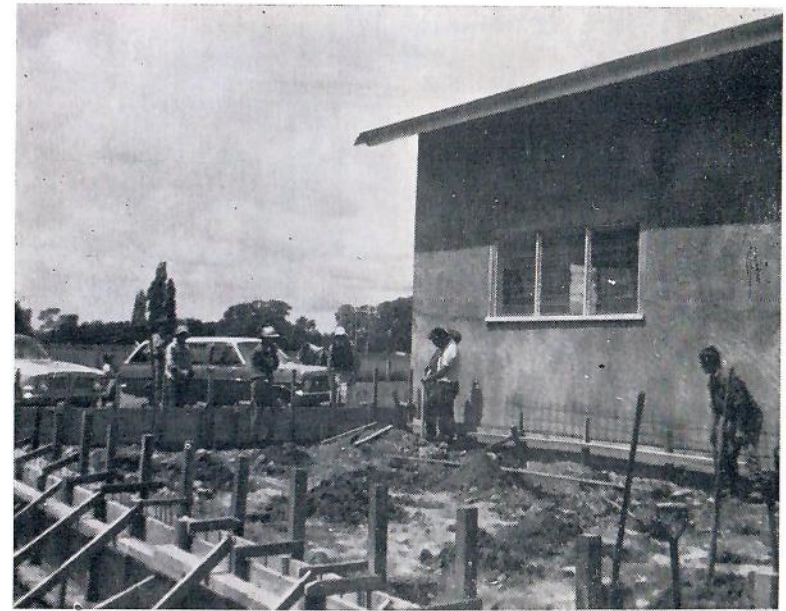
Since the start some fifteen hundred man hours have been put into the building to get it finished in time for the opening. Work gangs varied from twenty-four workers down to one or two. But over all there was a very good response from players and supporters.



The Club was also assisted in the project by tradesmen and other helpers. It is an outstanding feat to have these extensions completed and well on the way to being paid for in such a short period of time.

It is, however, impossible to mention the names of all

those who assisted, but the Club places on record in this Souvenir Programme, its sincere appreciation for all help given.

Secretary — 1960-61.

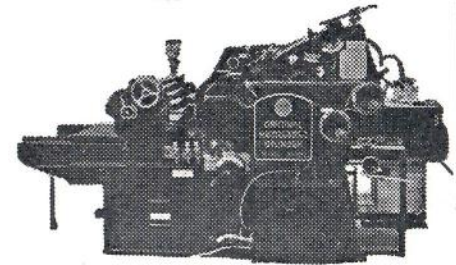
Chairman 1962. Management Committee — 1963-72.
